
HITCH MOUNTED MUD FLAPS SPECIAL CUTTING INSTRUCTIONS






▲ WARNING: Before installing mud flaps on dual exhaust vehicles ensure perforated regions are cut out, otherwise exhaust may cause damage to mud flaps or vehicle.

1: CUTTING PERFORATIONS

A. Before installing mud flaps to frame, cut out the perforated region in each mud flap.










2: INSTALLING HEAT SHIELD

A. Heat Shield installs between mud flaps and frame on both sides with existing hardware.

NOTE: Heat Shield will protrude though mud flaps.



B. For attaching mud flaps to frame, refer to standard instructions.

IMPORTANT: When installing mud flaps to frame, ensure mud flap cut out and Heat Shield aligns with exhaust cut out in frame.
