PREPARATION

Unpack set of two mud flaps with components. Clean vehicle wheel wells. For additional installation assistance, go to rockstarmudflaps.com for install video.

MUD FLAP COMPONENTS

- (2) Mud flaps
- (2) Mounting brackets
- (1) Cardboard guide
- (12) Nylon hex nuts (#8-32)
- (12) Self-drilling screws (#10 x 1-1/4")


TOOLS NEEDED

- Angled drill/screwdriver with 5/16 socket
- Locking pliers
- Marking pen
- Protective eyewear
- · Tape measure or ruler
- Straight edge
- Utility knife

NOTE: This document provides universal installation instructions for determining mounting hole locations, trimming mud flaps and installing mud flaps. The kit includes a cardboard guide to help identify mud flap mounting hole locations in the wheel well. Always verify mud flap is level before completing installation.

PARTS DIAGRAM

NOTE: Mud flaps may be purchased with or without pre-installed trim plates (not pictured). Trim plates are also available for purchase as an accessory.




1. PREPARING FOR INSTALLATION

A. Park on level ground with firm surface.


B. Check free space behind front tires when fully turned. Ensure enough space and clearance to accommodate 5/16" thick mud flaps.

NOTE: If trim plates are pre-installed, face them toward rear during installation



2. DETERMINE MUD FLAP MOUNTING LOCATION

A. Fold cardboard guide then insert bottom of mud flap into guide for an approximately level platform during installation.



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
2. DETERMINE MUD FLAP MOUNTING LOCATION (Continued)

B. Position mud flap with cardboard guide in wheel well and determine mounting screw locations. Verify screw mounting locations will contact metal backing as much as possible.

NOTE: If you intend to tow heavy loads, mud flaps are typically mounted higher than height provided by cardboard guide.

A CAUTION: Ensure all mounting hole sides are free of wiring, mechanical parts and are structurally sound.

NOTE: The adjacent illustration depicts one possibility for screw locations, other vehicles and installation methods may require different screw locations.




3. INSTALLING MUD FLAPS

A. With mud flap inserted in cardboard guide, use angled screwdriver with self-drilling screw to attach mud flap at first upper location.


B. Level mud flap while adjusting in and out to obtain best fit then tighten screw to hold in place.

C. Use angled screwdriver with self-drilling screws to attach mud flap at remaining screw hole locations.



D. Secure screws with nuts.

NOTE: Use sufficient screws and nuts. The kit provides 6 self-drilling screws (#10 x 1-1/4") and nylon hex nuts per mud flap (4 self-drilling screws and nuts if the stabilizing bracket is installed).



4. INSTALLING STABILIZING BRACKET

NOTE: The stabilizing bracket is often used to pull back front mud flap for additional tire clearance or square mud flap with tire.

A. From behind the mud flap, determine the stabilizing bracket mounting position. Stabilizing bracket should attach to mud flap and vehicle body.

B. Use locking pliers to bend stabilizing bracket as needed.

NOTE: Ensure bends in stabilizing bracket conform to mounting locations before attaching to mud flap and vehicle.

C. Use screwdriver with self-drilling screw to carefully drill a hole in mud flap, then remove screw.







4. INSTALLING STABILIZING BRACKET (Continued)

D. Insert screw from opposite side (closest to wheel) in mud flap, through stabilizing bracket and secure with nut.



E. With stabilizing bracket attached to mud flap, adjust stabilizing bracket until enough clearance is provided in wheel well.

F. Attach free end of stabilizing bracket to vehicle with self-drilling screw and secure with nut when possible.

G. Repeat process for remaining mud flaps.



SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

The operator can perform most of inspection and maintenance. It may be necessary to review the installation instructions.

- Periodically check all screws and nuts, retighten if needed.
- If mud flap has been damaged, replace with new one.

NOTE: Inspection and/or maintenance should be performed anytime a malfunction is observed or suspected. If you need assistance inspecting and/or servicing your mud flaps, call customer service at 888-568-3709. Always use original equipment replacement parts for your mud flaps.

Goods to be returned must have a pre-authorized RA # (Return Authorization Number) - obtained by calling the number above. Mark the number on the package and ship it freight prepaid to address below. Agri-Cover, Inc. will pay freight to return goods to sender.
