### **PREPARATION**

Unpack set of two mud flaps with components. Clean vehicle wheel wells. For additional installation assistance, go to rockstarmudflaps.com for install video.

#### **MUD FLAP COMPONENTS**

- (2) Mud flaps
- (2) #10 x 1-1/4" Self-drilling hex screws
- (2) #10 x 1/2" Washers
- (4) 7 mm Hex screws
- (1) Rear wheel well drill template (GMC only)
- (4) 10-24 x 1-1/2" Truss head screws (GMC only)
- (4) #10 x 1/2" Fender washers
- (4) 10-24 Serrated flange nuts

#### **TOOLS NEEDED**


- Angled drill/screwdriver
- Ratchet
- T15 Torx bit, 5/16" socket and 7 mm socket
- · Protective eyewear
- Masking tape
- Drill with 1/4" bit

**NOTE:** These instructions describe installing mud flaps on Chevrolet and GMC trucks, be aware, the front mud flap installation process is the same across brands while the rear is different. Hardware components and appearance may vary.

♠ CAUTION: These instructions involve drilling holes. Ensure all mounting hole sides are free of wiring, mechanical parts and are structurally sound.

# PARTS & FASTENER MOUNTING DIAGRAM

**NOTE:** Mud flaps may be purchased with or without pre-installed trim plates (not pictured). Trim plates are also available for purchase as an accessory.




# 1. PREPARING FOR INSTALLATION

- A. Park on level ground with firm surface.
- B. Check free space behind front tires when fully turned. Ensure enough space and clearance to accommodate 5/16" thick mud flaps.



**NOTE:** If trim plates are pre-installed, face them toward tailgate during installation.


- C. To install mud flaps, perform one of the following:
- See Step 2 for front wheel well installation
- See Step 3 (page 5) for Chevy rear wheel well installation
- See Step 4 (page 6) for GMC rear wheel well installation



# 2. INSTALLING MUD FLAPS TO FRONT


**NOTE:** Front mud flap installation uses 3 holes per mud flap, see PARTS DIAGRAM (page 2) for locations.

A. Use T15 Torx bit to remove lower factory screws indicated in adjacent image.



B. Install mud flaps with (2) 7 mm hex screws through 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> slotted holes into newly free holes in wheel well. Leave screws loose for now.


C. Level mud flap while adjusting placement to obtain best fit then tighten screws to hold in place.



# 2. INSTALLING MUD FLAPS TO FRONT (Continued)

D. Verify mud flap is level then install (1) 10 x 1-1/4" self-drilling hex screw with washer at upper mounting hole. Ensure screws contact metal backing as much as possible

E. Repeat for remaining front mud flap.




# 3. CHEVY REAR MUD FLAP INSTALLATION

**NOTE:** Rear mud flap installation uses 3 mounting holes per mud flap, see PARTS DIAGRAM (page 2) for locations.

A. Repeat front installation except attach mud flap with 7 mm screws with washers at 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> holes (instead of 3<sup>rd</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> holes).

B. Repeat for remaining rear mud flap.



# 4. GMC REAR MUD FLAP INSTALLATION

**NOTE:** Rear mud flap installation uses 3 mounting holes per mud flap, see PARTS DIAGRAM (page 2) for locations.

A. Two templates are supplied on a single sheet of paper. Carefully cut out each template.


B. Align template with bottom corner of wheel well (behind wheel). Use masking tape to hold in place.


C. Drill hole in location indicated by template with 1/4" drill bit.

D. Install mud flaps with (2) 10-24 x 1-1/2" truss head screws and washers through 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> slotted holes into newly drilled wheel well holes.

E. Secure screws with nuts and leave loose for now.

F. Level mud flap while adjusting placement to obtain best fit then tighten screws to hold in place.






# 4. GMC REAR MUD FLAP INSTALLATION (Continued)

G. Verify mud flap is level then install (1) 10 x 1-1/4" self-drilling hex screw at upper mounting hole. Ensure screws contact metal backing as much as possible.

H. Repeat for remaining rear mud flap.



# SAFETY AND MAINTENANCE

The operator can perform most of inspection and maintenance. It may be necessary to review the installation instructions.

- Periodically check all screws, washers and nuts, retighten if needed.
- If mud flap has been damaged, replace with new one.

**NOTE**: Inspection and/or maintenance should be performed anytime a malfunction is observed or suspected. If you need assistance inspecting and/or servicing your mud flaps, call customer service at 888-568-3709. Always use original equipment replacement parts for your mud flaps.
