# 2001-05 CHEVY/GMC 6' 6" STEPSIDE COMPOSITE BOX

## **PREPARATION**


#### **TOOLS NEEDED**

- (1) Ratchet with 7/16" socket and 5/16" socket
- (1) 5/16" Wrench
- (1) Drill with 1/4" bit
- (1) Protective eyewear

**▲** CAUTION: Over torquing hardware may damage components. Do not use impact tools.

IMPORTANT: Before installing this product, ensure truck has composite walls inside box and does not have inside lip.

## TOP VIEW OF COMPOSITE BOX




Push side rail forward against front of box and align as shown in following steps. Use pre-punched holes in side rail as guide for drilling locations. Work front to back.

## 1. INSTALLING SIDE RAILS


A. With side rail in position as shown, drill 1/4" hole through composite and steel stake pocket. Use bolt, washer and lock nut to fasten tight.

**NOTE:** Use 5/16" wrench to tighten bolt and 7/16" socket with ratchet for nut.



B. At second pre-punched hole, hold side rail flush with top of box. Turn self-drilling screw through wall and into steel brace. Repeat this step at third hole.

▲ CAUTION: Carefully turn self-drilling screw to ensure it does not strip threads.



- C. Align side rail height with tailgate. Drill 1/4" hole into composite wall and stake pocket. Use bolt, washer and lock nut to fasten.
- D. Repeat Step 1 to install side rail on opposite side.
- E. For remaining cover installation, refer to standard instructions.
